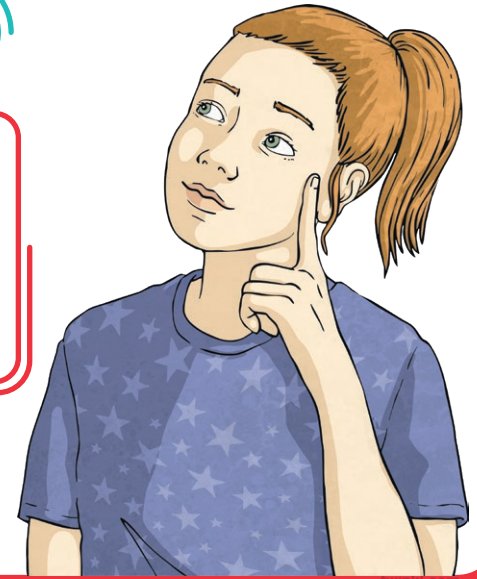

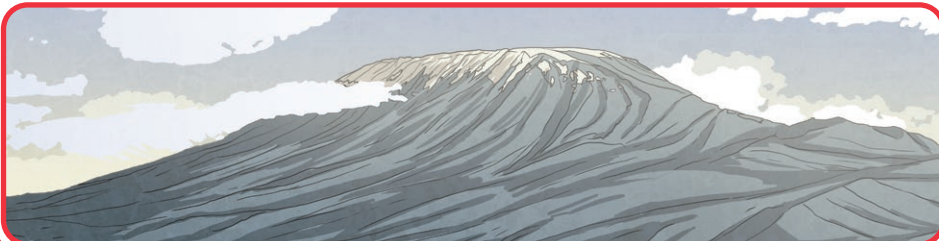
One aim of Comic Relief is to tackle world hunger. If £3 billion could provide food to save the lives of 2 million children, how many children could receive food for £9 billion?

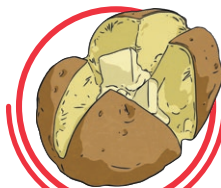
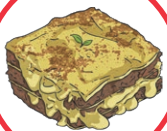
