

Combining Numbers

Sensory Bottle

You will need:

Plastic bottle

Water

Vegetable oil

Tape/glue gun

5 coloured marbles

5 small coloured pom-poms

Glycerine

Method

- 1. Half fill the bottle with water.
- 2. Fill the remaining space (to just under full) with oil.
- 3. Add a few drops of glycerine to the bottle.
- 4. Add the marbles and pom-poms.
- 5. Secure the lid with tape/glue.
- 6. With the children, count the objects in the bottle. Have fun shaking the bottle. Watch the water and oil mix and then separate, splitting the objects into 2 groups. Count each group separately and then altogether.
- 7. A great activity showing how 10 can be split up into two groups and the total remains the same.
