



Glitter Feather

Sensory Bottle

You will need:

500ml bottle

Feathers

Glitter glue

Jewels

Water

Strong glue



Method

1. Fill the bottle two thirds full with water.
2. Add a good squeeze of glitter glue.
3. Put the lid on the bottle and shake it to mix the glue and water.
4. Remove the lid and add a few drops of food colouring (not too much as the babies need to be able to see what is inside).
5. Next, add 2 or 3 feathers and a selection of jewels.
6. Secure the lid on the bottle with strong glue. Leave time for it to set, as per the instructions of the bottle of glue.
7. The bottle is now ready for the children to explore and see what they can find.
