

Ocean Sensory Bottle

You will need:

Water

Cooking oil

Blue food colouring

Large bottle

Funnel

Glue gun or strong glue

Method

- 1. Fill your bottle approximately $\frac{1}{3}$ full with water.
- 2. Add several drops of food colouring.
- 3. With the lid in place, shake the bottle to disperse the food colouring.
- 4. Top the bottle up with oil.
- 5. Once all the materials are in the bottle, glue the lid on for safety.
- 6. Tip the bottle upside down and watch the ocean come alive.
